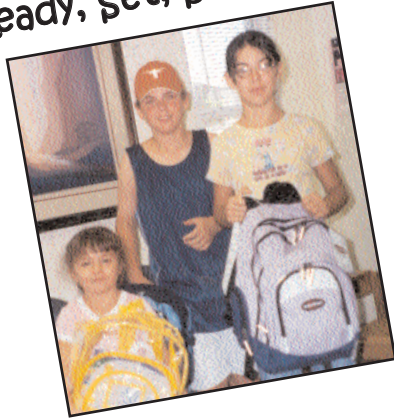

REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVICE

•Current proof of address

This must be postdated in the past 30 days and have the name of one of the heads of household on the address. A phone bill or utility bill is adequate.

•Current proof of income for all adults over 18

This should be a pay stub dated within the last 30 days, an award letter for Food Stamps, SSI, Unemployment or an application for any of the above or a job application.

•A current picture ID

•Clients must live within western or unincorporated Arapahoe County or northern Douglas County

•Clients must fall within these income guidelines:
