At this event, you can sample more than 300 wines, spirits and beers from around the world, coupled with wonderful offerings from local restaurants such as Alamo Draft House, Bad Daddy Burger, Polidori Sausage, Blue Bell Ice Cream, Los Dos Portillos, Corner Bakery, Root 25, The Melting Pot, Piccolo's, Nothing Bundt Cakes, Red Bird Farms, Romano's Restaurant, Tico's Mexican, Torchies Tacos, Seasons 52 Fresh Grill with more joining in. 

BEING A TABLE CAPTAIN

How do I get started?

- Think of friends and colleagues who have a desire to help end homelessness and hunger in our community.
- Make a list of people whom you think would want to learn more and be part of the solution.
- Send them a “Save the Date” email or postcard with a little note from you. An electronic email template will be supplied to you.
- Follow up with a phone call or a note to personally invite them to sit at your table.
- Once guests accept your invitation to join your table, send us a list of your invited guests, by February 1, 2023.

How do I confirm my guests' attendance?

- Your guests are considered “confirmed” when we receive their name on the list or have registered online, with payment (Please see enclosed sheet titled “Table Captain”).

What Happens at the event?

At the event, your guest will:

- Win the Community Cup for the Top Fundraising Table
- Sample dozens of wine and food vendors
- Bid on Silent and Live Auction items
- Learn more about IFCS and how the organization provides critical resources to alleviate homelessness and hunger.

As a table captain, you will be recognized in the event program.



What do I need to know?

Price: Table of 10 is \$990 before February 1 or \$1100 in February. Advance table sponsors receive a discount equal to one guest ticket. Advanced purchase individual tickets for event, not sold as a table, are \$110. If the event is not sold out, tickets at the door are \$125.

Table Capacity: Tables will be set for 10. Please fill all 10 seats. Remember to count yourself as an occupant of the 10 seats you are to fill! Please let us know if you have any special requests for seating preferences.



	Make follow-up calls to invitees	Week of January 9, 2023 - Continue to follow-up with your guests. Remind your guests about the date and time of event. They can register at www.ifcs.org .
	Submit guest roster (Table Captain Sheet)	February 6, 2023 – For guests who aren't able to make it, invite them to learn more about IFCS.

TABLE CAPTAIN TOP 10 TIPS

- 1. Invite nine guest to join you and fill your table of 10.** Consider friends, family, associates and business contacts that may be willing to support IFCS and its goals.
- 2. Excitement is contagious and helps create momentum!** Let people know your personal connection to IFCS. Why do you support this cause? Your story often means so much to your friends and colleagues as it means to you.
- 3. Challenge your best friend or a previous table guest or two to step up to the Captain level and fill their own table!** Contact the development office by calling 303-725-9894 or emailing Todd McPherson at toddm@ifcs.org to have a Table Captain packet sent on your behalf.
- 4. Be up front about the event being a fundraiser.** Tell your guests that the purpose of this event is to raise both awareness of IFCS' mission and programs and the funds to further those programs.
- 5. Write personal notes on the invitations that you mail or hand-deliver to your invitees.** Also, add a sentence about Nibbles and Sips to your email signature as a way to remind people that you are often in contact with. We will provide the post cards for you to distribute.
- 6. Follow-up with people you don't hear back from.** Just because they don't RSVP doesn't mean they are not interested in attending the event. People get busy and forget to RSVP even though they have every intention of attending the event.
- 7. Confirm your guest list and submit to IFCS by February 6, 2023.**
- 8. Two to three days before the event, send a reminder email or phone call to your table guests.**
- 9. Personally thank your guests at the event.** Small tokens of appreciation and thank-you cards set at your guests' place setting before they arrive is a special way to show your gratitude for their support of IFCS.
- 10. Have Fun!** This is the most important tip of them all – have fun as you are recruiting. Enjoy the fact that you are doing a wonderful thing to alleviate hunger and homelessness in our community.


